

Session 2 | Becoming Like Him - The Fruit of the Spirit

Session Overview

This session focuses on the fruit of the Holy Spirit as a reflection of God's character, and how we grow in this fruit by abiding in Jesus, understanding our identity in Christ, and renewing our minds.

Key Scripture

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control..."

Galatians 5:22-23 (ESV)

What Is the Fruit of the Spirit?

The fruit of the Spirit is a natural result of the Holy Spirit living in us. Just as apple trees bear apples, the Spirit of God produces fruit that reflects who He is.

Each "fruit" reflects God's nature:

- Love God *is* love (1 John 4:16)
- Joy Deep gratitude in all seasons (James 1:2-4)
- Peace Shalom; peace of heart and peace with others
- Patience God's mercy and slowness to anger (1 Corinthians 14)
- Kindness God's kindness leads to repentance
- Goodness His righteousness and holiness
- Faithfulness Deep trust in God's character
- Gentleness Power under control
- Self-Control Strength to resist the flesh

We Reflect the Spirit by Abiding in Jesus

"Abide in me... whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit."

John 15:1-8

- · Jesus is the vine; we are the branches
- We bear fruit as we stay connected to Him
- This fruit proves we are His disciples

You Are a Temple of the Holy Spirit

"...your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you..."

1 Corinthians 6:19

- You are God's dwelling place
- The Holy Spirit lives in you (Romans 8:11)
- · Heaven meets earth through you

Character Development, not Behaviour Modification

- · We don't try to force fruit by willpower
- Like trees, we bear fruit naturally as we grow in Christ
- It's not about trying harder but about yielding more

"Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit..."

Zechariah 4:6

Identity in Christ

As we believe in Jesus, we become:

- A new creation (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Chosen, holy, royal (Ephesians 1:3-4) (1 Peter 2:9)
- Joined to the Lord (1 Corinthians 6:17)
- Born again through faith in the Son (Galatians 2:20)
- Adopted as sons and daughters (Romans 8:14-15)

Fruit comes from who we are, not just what we do.

Renewing Your Mind

"...be transformed by the renewing of your mind."

Romans 12:1-2

- We put off the old self (flesh)
- We put on the new self (spirit-led life)

• The Spirit empowers us to live in righteousness and holiness (Ephesians 4:22-24)

The Battle Between Flesh and Spirit

"The acts of the flesh are obvious... but the fruit of the Spirit is..."
Galatians 5:19-22

- We all have a sinful nature, but we are no longer defined by it
- As we submit to the Holy Spirit, He helps us walk in freedom and fruitfulness

- Which fruit is God highlighting to you today?
- What is the Holy Spirit saying about your identity?
- Ask: "Holy Spirit, how do You see me?"
