- 1. 1973 Saved during the Jesus People Movement (see When Jesus Met Hippies)
- 2. 1986 Filled with the Spirit as a young pastor at a Birmingham conference
- 3. 2025 Current 'liturgy': "Holy Spirit, thank you I'm your temple"
- *Personal devotion: Ephesians 3:16–19 & Romans 5:5 have become living prayers.

♦ 2. The Holy Spirit is God

Divine Person – Not a force or feeling!

- Equal with the Father and the Son
 - ➤ See: Matthew 28:19; 1 Cor. 12:4–6; 2 Cor. 13:14; Eph. 4:4–6; 1 Peter 1:2
- · Deity clearly stated
 - ➤ Acts 5:3–4 Lying to the Spirit = lying to God
- Born of the Spirit = Born of God
 - ➤ John 3:3,7 \(\Sigma\) John 1:13; 1 John 3:9

A Person, not a Power

- Mind Romans 8:27
- Will 1 Corinthians 12:11
- Emotions Ephesians 4:30; Isaiah 63:10
- 🖨 You can't grieve a chair-leg! He is *relational* .

♦ 3. The Holy Spirit in the Trinity

The Trinity = Divine Relationship

- Son sent by the Father (John's Gospel)
- Spirit sent by the Son (John 16:7)

♦ 5. The Spirit in Community

The Spirit is for the whole Church, not just individuals.

- Many New Testament commands are *plural* (e.g. Eph. 5:18 "be filled" = you all)
- Western mindset often reads Scripture too individually.

AJW's Message: How to make the Holy Spirit feel at home in your church

Negative	Positive Opposite
Resisted? (Acts 7:51)	Welcome Him
Grieved? (Eph. 4:30)	Please Him
Quenched? (1 Thess. 5:19)	Fan the flame!

Ephesians shows the Spirit working through the Church:

- Sealing (1:13–14)
- Inhabiting (2:22)
- Educating (3:4–5)
- *Unifying* (4:3)
- Filling (5:18)
- Arming (6:18)
